How To Apply

Please complete and submit our online application form by clicking <u>here</u>. As part of the application form, you'll be asked to answer a few supplementary questions and upload your resume. The deadline to apply is **Tuesday**, **October 7th**, **2025**, **at 11:59pm EST**.

By **Thursday**, **October 9th**, you'll be notified via email as to whether you've been invited to the next stage of the application process. This will be a virtual interview with our HR Director, Dilara Basegmez, or our VP of Internal strategy, Sofia Scasserra and 2 directors from the Business Development team. Interviews will take place from **Friday**, **October 10th to Wednesday**, **October 15th**.

On **Thursday, October 16th**, you will receive an email from the MESA Co-Presidents with a link to submit your rankings. You will be requested to rank all positions across the One Club Policy (OCP) clubs that you applied for and would like to be considered for. <u>OCP clubs include MESA, MIBA, HRA, IS, TMG, MTA, ACE and AOA.</u>

You will have until **Sunday, October 19th** to submit your rankings. In the meantime, all OCP clubs that you have applied for will be ranking you among the other candidates under consideration. On **Tuesday, October 21st**, you will hear from our HR Director if you have been matched with MESA for any of our associate positions.
